PARTNER

Partner members of NFA are flood industry stakeholders such as claims adjusters, flood vendors, insurance companies (WYO and insurers writing private flood), lenders, insurance brokers and offshore entities.

Dues: \$2000

As a partner member, your company

- has full voting privileges for the Board, bylaws, changes, etc.;
